Psalm 105:1-6, 23-26

- ¹O give thanks to the LORD, call on his name, make known his deeds among the peoples.
- ² Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wonderful works.
- ³ Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice.
- ⁴ Seek the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually.
- ⁵ Remember the wonderful works he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he has uttered,
- ⁶ O offspring of his servant Abraham, children of Jacob, his chosen ones. (top)

- ²³ Then Israel came to Egypt; Jacob lived as an alien in the land of Ham.
- ²⁴ And the LORD made his people very fruitful, and made them stronger than their foes,
- ²⁵ whose hearts he then turned to hate his people, to deal craftily with his servants.
- ²⁶ He sent his servant Moses, and Aaron whom he had chosen. (top)

Matthew 16:21-28

²¹ From that time on, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised.

²² And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, "God forbid it, Lord! This must never happen to you."

²³ But he turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; for you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things."

²⁴ Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.

²⁵ For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it.

²⁶ For what will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their life? Or what will they give in return for their life?

²⁷ "For the Son of Man is to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay everyone for what has been done.

²⁸ Truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom." (top)
