## Genesis 1:1-5

- <sup>1</sup> In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- <sup>2</sup> Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.
- <sup>3</sup> And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.
- <sup>4</sup> God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.
- <sup>5</sup> God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day. (top)

Mark 1:4-11

- <sup>4</sup> And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.
- <sup>5</sup> The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.
- <sup>6</sup> John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey.
- <sup>7</sup> And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie.
- <sup>8</sup> I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." The Baptism and Testing of Jesus
- <sup>9</sup> At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.
- <sup>10</sup> Just as Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove.
- <sup>11</sup> And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." (top)
