



Black History Month: February. This is the annual observance of the history of the African diaspora. It has been observed in the month of February in the United States and Canada since 1976. It was begun as Negro History Week by historian Carter G. Woodson in 1926 with the goal of educating the American people about African American history. It concentrates on the cultural backgrounds and achievements of African Americans.

Black History Month Spotlight: Ella Josephine Baker (December 13, 1903 - December 13, 1986) was a civil rights activist and community organizer. She co-founded an organization that raised money to fight Jim Crow Laws and worked with Martin Luther King Jr.'s SCLC. She assisted in organizing the 1961 Freedom Rides and registering Black voters.
