Black History Month: February. This is the annual observance of the history of the African diaspora. It has been observed in the month of February in the United States and Canada since 1976. It was begun as Negro History Week by historian Carter G. Woodson in 1926 with the goal of educating the American people about African American history. It concentrates on the cultural backgrounds and achievements of African Americans.

Black History Month Spotlight: Harry Hosier (c. 1750 - May 1806) was the first black preacher licensed to preach in the Methodist church. His sermon, "The Barren Fig Tree," that was preached at Adam's Chapel in Fairfax County, Virginia, in May of 1781 was the first recorded Methodist sermon by a Black person in America.
