Black History Month: February. This is the annual observance of the history of the African diaspora. It has been observed in the month of February in the United States and Canada since 1976. It was begun as Negro History Week by historian Carter G. Woodson in 1926 with the goal of educating the American people about African American history. It concentrates on the cultural backgrounds and achievements of African Americans.

Black History Month Spotlight: Charles Albert Tindley (July 7, 1851 – July 26, 1933) was a gospel music composer and Methodist minister. In 1902 Tindley was appointed pastor of Calvary Methodist Church where he served until his death in 1933. Tindley was a noted songwriter and composer of gospel hymns and is recognized as one of the founding fathers of American gospel music.
