## Luke 24:36-48

- <sup>36</sup> While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you."
- <sup>37</sup> They were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost.
- <sup>38</sup> He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?
- <sup>39</sup> Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see, for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."
- <sup>40</sup> And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.
- <sup>41</sup> Yet for all their joy they were still disbelieving and wondering, and he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?"
- <sup>42</sup> They gave him a piece of broiled fish,
- <sup>43</sup> and he took it and ate in their presence.
- <sup>44</sup> Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled."
- <sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures,
- <sup>46</sup> and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day
- <sup>47</sup> and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.
- <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things.
